- Bishop Johnston will celebrate a special Mass at Blessed Sacrament in Bethany on Monday July 29 at 5:00 pm with a reception to follow Mass. The saints honored that day, Sts. Martha, Mary and Lazarus have been named the patron saints of the city of Bethany by the bishop.
- On Saturday August 3, Bishop Johnston will celebrate Mass at 6:30 pm at Mary Immaculate in Gallatin. After Mass he is going to Tom and Monica Bonderer's farm at 10115 Vista Ave., Winston, for a Blessing of farm animals. After the blessing, there will be an ice cream social at Tom and Monica's house. - These events would be a very good opportunity for all parishioners from Mary Immaculate, Blessed Sacrament, Immaculate Heart of Mary and St. Joseph's to attend. He does remember when people come out and support things like solemn Masses and the blessing of farm animals. Plus it is an opportunity to meet people from other parishes that we might not otherwise interact with.
