- It is time tot think about religious education for our youth this fall. If you have children and would like to enroll them in classes, please let Fr. Leete know. The Diocese will work with you to get you certified with some online instruction. Our children need to learn about their faith through parents and through formal church religious education. Can we work together to start the ball rolling and to come up with a plan? Maybe St. Joseph's and Immaculate Heart of Mary could work together ona program?
- The Mass time at IHM Princeton will change to 1:30 pm on the first and third Sunday of the month. This will begin on Sunday July 21.
