

His Excellency Most Reverend James V. Johnston, Jr. Bishop of Kansas City – St. Joseph

Decree Regarding the Requested Revocation or Emendation of my Decree Amalgamating Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, Princeton to Saint Joseph Parish, Trenton

Whereas the "Remonstratio" dated April 29, 2024, presented by Mr. Seth Renfro, parishioner, submitted by certified mail through the United States Postal Service on the same date of April 29, 2024, and in accord with canon 1734, §1, seeking my revocation or emendation of my Decree dated April 19, 2024, was received in my office on May 2, 2024, within the ten useful days as stipulated in canon 1734, §2; and

Whereas, despite the fact that the plethora of procurator mandates received raised validity questions since, for example, only twenty were of duly registered parishioners, forty were offered by women in a sorority house within another diocese, at least fifteen from non-Missouri states, as well as significant signed mandates of Missouri residents further than twenty-five miles from the parish boundaries requiring that all of the aforementioned mandates would necessarily warrant further investigation; and

Whereas I have prayerfully considered all that has been presented in the aforementioned petition, and I have continued to discuss possibilities with local priests, diocesan leaders and others, after due canonical consultations and prayer, I have determined that the strengthening of the community of faith and discipleship can be achieved with the separation of the parishes remaining. However, I have also determined that is it necessary to limit by particular law the number of weekend Masses that a priest is permitted to celebrate between these parishes and his other parochial and sacramental assignments.

THEREFORE

I, the Most Reverend James V. Johnston, Jr., by the grace of God and the favor of the Apostolic See, Bishop of Kansas City - Saint Joseph, hereby declare in accordance with canon 57, §1, my revocation of my Decree, dated April 19, 2024, Amalgamating Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, Princeton, to Saint Joseph Parish, Trenton.
